

Training Phases A, B & C

INITIAL TRAINING ASSESSMENT FORM

Phase A

- Clicker loading and evaluation
- Collar response
- Food refusal
- Obedience
- Begin converting CCI commands to D4D commands
- Overall evaluation of dog's needs
- Continued socialization

Phase A | End

- Dog yields to collar pressure.
- Dog has general understanding of obedience with minor distractions.
- Dog has general food refusal.

Phase B

- Evaluate clicker response
- Continue with obedience, collar response, and food refusal with increasing difficulty
- Phase out CCI commands to D4D commands
- Continue socialization

Phase B | End

- Dog has good understanding of obedience, food refusal, and collar response with moderate distractions.
- Dog has good social skills.

Phase C

- Maintain obedience, food refusal, and collar response
- Use D4D commands only
